



LOWLAND MALTS

- Auchentoshan 10 year (och'n'tosh'n) – clean & fresh, lemongrass, gingery crisp, subtle - 8
- Glenkinchie 12 year – soft, grassy sweetness, clean & well-defined, finish becoming spicy - 9

HIGHLAND MALTS

- Aberfeldy 12 year – heather honey softness, full body, gentle syrupy thickness - 8
- Clynelish 14 year Coastal Highland (klyn-leesh) – maritime character; oily, malty, becoming fruity-spicy, mustard cress - 9
- Dalwhinnie 15 year Mountain Highland – *Scotland's highest distillery produces "the gentle spirit"* very aromatic; heather honey, malty sweetness, peat, long finish - 11
- Glenmorangie 10 year (glen-MORanjee) – *from the tallest stills in Scotland "only the lightest spirits can ascend to such heights"* spicy & flowery, lighter side of medium body, malty sweet, creamy & rounded - 8
- Glenmorangie 12 year The Quinta Ruban Port Wood – chocolate, full, velvety texture, sweet with some mint - 14
- Glenmorangie 12 year The Lasanta Sherry Wood – honey & vanilla, rich, full body, nutty - 14
- Highland Park 12 year Orkney Islands – smoky, exceptionally smooth, succulent, heather honey maltiness; teasing & delicious - 8
- Highland Park 18 year Orkney Islands – smooth & balanced, toffee sweetness, mouth-wateringly smoky finish - 17
- Oban 14 year Western Highland – peaty smokiness, quite rich, dry, malty & fruity undertones, aromatic finish - 11
- Springbank 10 year Campbeltown – salt spray, smoke, coconut & toffee, extraordinarily long finish - 14
- Talisker 10 year Isle of Skye – pungent, slightly syrupy, smoky & big pepperiness, long, huge finish - 11

SPEYSIDE MALTS

- Aberlour 12 year Double Cask Matured (aber-lower) – nutty, soft-textured, medium body, spicy; sherry-accented - 8
- Balvenie 12 year Double Wood – vanilla spiciness, complex, rich, honey sweetness; delicate sherry layer - 11
- Benromach Organic – *first-use organic casks* – smooth & sweet, oak, vanilla & toffee - 14
- Cragganmore 12 year – complex, herbal aroma, medium, yet firm & smooth, delicate, flowery notes, long finish - 9
- Glenfiddich 12 year – light, fresh pear, lean & smooth, fruity with some smoke, restrained finish - 8
- Glenfiddich 15 year Solera Reserve – *vatted* – fruit & spice, layered richness, gratifying finish - 11
- Glenfiddich 18 year – smooth, mellow spiced-apple, robust oak, depth & complexity - 14
- The Glenlivet 12 year – fresh flowers, light to medium body, peachy & vanilla, gently warming finish - 8
- The Glenlivet 15 year French Oak Reserve – *new, limousin cask-matured* fruity, floral aromas, dry cedarwood, spicy, creamy finish - 11
- The Glenlivet 16 year Nadurra Cask Strength – soft fruits, silky, honeyed flowers, oak finish - 14
- The Glenlivet 18 year – *"The Sean Connery of Single Malts"* heather, sherry, smooth, memorable finish; serves nicely before & after dinner - 14
- The Glenlivet 21 year Archive Special Edition – emphatic sherry character; fruity, elegant richness, toffee & caramel - 19
- The Macallan 12 year – sherry & honey notes, full body, flowering currant, satisfying finish - 9
- The Macallan 18 year – big bouquet, some peat, soft body, nutty-sweet, sherry accent, warming finish - 21
- The Macallan Cask Strength – *intense expression of a classic Macallan* sherry aroma, rounded body, nutty palate, spicy finish - 14

ISLAY MALTS

from the island of Islay, pronounced "eye-luh"

- Ardbeg 10 year – smoke, brine, & iodine; a light heavyweight, sweet, mean & moody; hefty finish - 11
- Caol Ila 12 year (cull-eye-luh) – *"Islay's hidden malt, cooled by crisp sea waters"* fresh sea-air aromas, light oily body, peaty, spicy & olive-like, peppery finish - 11
- Bowmore 18 year – *"Original Islay distillery, legalized in 1779"* complex & medicinal, medium body, dry creaminess & leafy smokiness - 17
- Laphroaig 10 year (la-froyg) – medicinal & seaweedy, medium body, oily & salty, round & very dry - 9
- Laphroaig Original Cask Strength – as the 10 year, yet drier & earthier, even tar-like; wonderfully complex - 14
- Lagavulin 16 year (lagga-voolin) – *"Time, say the Islanders, Takes out the fire, but leaves in the warmth."* intense dryness, full body, smoky & salty; like campfire remains, the morning after a rain - 14
